Stop the 3 Putt

Try this putting drill to help avoid the nasty 3 putt. For this drill you will need 5 golf balls, 1 yellow and 4 white. The focus of this drill is to develop FEEL, so we will be putting to a spot instead of a hole. Begin by aiming and putting the yellow ball to a spot around 20 feet away, DON'T LOOK UP. You will then try to repeat that same stroke with the 4 white balls attempting to get them as close to the first yellow ball as you can. You are not allowed to look up until after you have struck all 5 golf

balls. Once you have mastered this without looking up, move to a longer putt of say 30 feet and try to do the same thing. For clarification or help see Joseph Hanko, PGA in the golf shop
