Stop the 3 Putt with the Ladder Drill

Create a speed "ladder" with tees placed at 3' increments, start at 6' and go to 24', 8 tees total. Roll a ball that stops between tees 1 and 2 (pretending there is a hole there, this gives you 18" in front and behind the ball), then the next one between the next set of tees until you are at the top of the ladder. Repeat in reverse. Do this drill once a week to dramatically improve your distance control.
